

What do you need to be a self-prosumer?

1. To be an electricity customer that has an electricity supply contract with a licensed supplier.
2. Shall install a photovoltaic panel at the facility on your ownership/usage according to MIE order No.3, 20/06/2019.
3. Shall apply to Customer Care Centers of the DSO, to benefit from the electricity self-prosumer status.
4. Shall execute the tariff payment for the application to get the self-prosumer status, according to the required installed capacity, but not more than 500 kWh.
5. Shall complete the legal, technical requirements to benefit from the self-producer status of electricity that include: the completion of the application form, its average consumption declaration during one year.
6. Shall get the approval of your request to self-produce energy. The DSO shall approve or refuse the request within 30 days.
7. With the approval of the DSO, you have the right to connect with the network.
8. The amount of the energy produced from your photovoltaic panel, calculated over the approved price, where the electricity surplus, bigger than the monthly consumption, shall be sold to the Universal Service Supplier for self-consumption from this category of customers.
